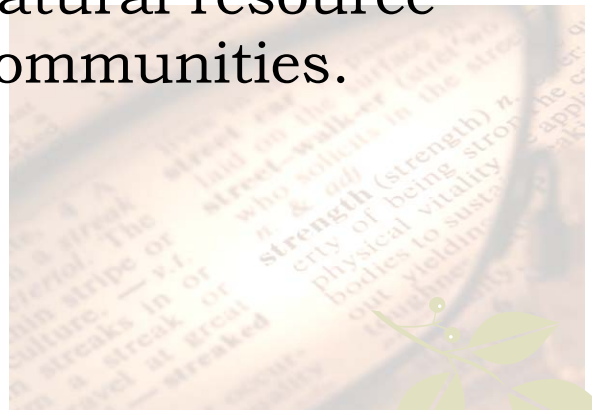
Mission Statement

Guiding Goals



The AgForestry Leadership Program:

- Presents a series of 14 seminars over an 18-month period, designed to broaden the knowledge base, the skills, and the motivation for leadership of its participants.
- Utilizes and calls upon AgForestry graduates to serve as leaders, presenters, and facilitators of these 14 seminars.
- Designs seminars that are modeled on the principles of adult learning styles with emphasis on current and complete information; interactive learning experiences; awareness of learning styles of participants.
- Enthusiastically discovers and supports opportunities for participants to take responsibility for their own learning, setting the environment for seminars, and leading whenever possible.

Guiding Principles

- Every participant is already a leader who is eager to acquire more knowledge and stronger skills.
- Every participant will have impact on and be a change agent at the local, state, and national levels, both during and after completing the AgForestry Leadership Program.
- Every participant is expected to come to all sessions ready and willing to participate and respect the different needs, styles, and beliefs of their peers.
